

Professional Conduct Notification

Notification: The Supreme Court of Nova Scotia issued an Order against Adam Kiril McCannel. Pursuant to the terms of the Order:

- it is declared that Adam Kiril McCannel contravened the *Paramedics Act*, SNS 2015, c 33, by disclosing confidential information pertaining to the College's professional conduct process and representing himself as a paramedic while not holding a licence to practise paramedicine;
- an interim injunction is issued against Adam Kiril McCannel restraining and enjoining him from:
 - (a) disclosing, by any means, including by social media or any other electronic or digital media, all complaints and all information pertaining to complaints received or under investigation, all information gathered in the course of the professional conduct process, and all proceedings and decisions of a disciplinary committee that are not open to or available to the public in accordance with the *Paramedics Act* or the Regulations; and
 - (b) holding himself out in any way to be entitled to practise paramedicine, or assuming any title or description implying or designed to lead the public to believe that he is entitled to practise paramedicine, unless and until he is licenced by the College to practise paramedicine.
